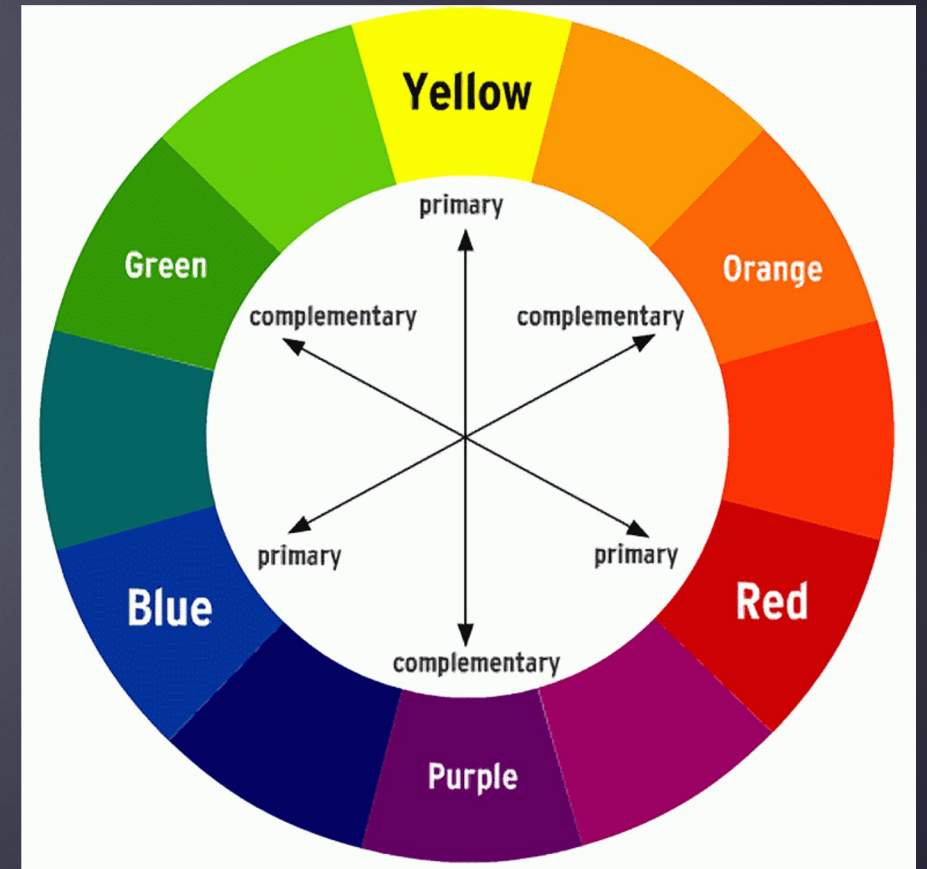

# Complimentary colors

- ▶ The color wheel:
  - ▶ **Primary colors:** Red, yellow, blue
  - ▶ **Complimentary pairs:** red–green, blue–orange, and yellow–purple
  - ▶ **Secondary colors:** Orange, green, violet/purple
- ▶ RGB color model
- ▶ CMY color model
- ▶ Color theory





# Rule of thirds

- ▶ Vertical and horizontal lines
- ▶ Divided by thirds to create balance and visual flow
